



Have you ever seen the biggest succulent in the world?

the biggest flowering tree in the world?

the biggest Baobab in the world?

It is actually all three in one and in global terms right in front of our door step, only 450kmdistant. This time, when they were building the tar road, the Baobabs won the battle-the road is winding around them!

And the weird and wonderful and ancient plants and trees in that region like the huge Sesame bushes(bottom foto)! A small localised threatened forest of them. A trip all the way up to the R525 and the gravel roads is all its worth!

But what is news from our nursery besides our normal range of plants?

-There are a number of the weird Sesame bushes, easy growers and quietly pushing forward.

-Looking for unusual shapes and character as a focus point?:

Small to extra large (14yrs) winter flowering Impala lilies and those from Arabia are available.

In a miniature form, but almost as old, are the Raphionacmes, Pachypodium succulentum and Pachypodium hybrids(bigger flowers)will be flowering soon in pink and white –are very tough against cold and drought! Big sizes are offered for the first time – really beautiful!

-In limited numbers are available :

For the first time Pachypodium brevicaule (grafted on hardy rootstock) makes them not only survive well but also grow in front of your eyes. So are the grafted Adenia pechuellis

-Dioscorea elephantipes and Cyphostemma uter

-Cacti(Ariocarpus,Pelecyphora),Pterodiscus and Ceropegias in hanging pots will be ready from October

- Bulbuous Ceropegias and Brachystelmas will be available from January next year
